## **Plastic Surgery Levels of Care**

### 1. Types of supervision

- a. Direct: the faculty or supervising resident is in the room or scrubbed for key
- b. Indirect: the faculty or supervising resident is in the hospital or clinical site and is immediately available.
- c. Oversight: the supervising physician is available to provide review of procedure/encounters with feedback after care is provided.
- d. The faculty member, at their discretion, may allow direct supervision of junior resident by senior residents, with the faculty providing indirect supervision
- e. Faculty members, at their discretion, may directly supervise any level of resident.

#### **KEY**

## \* Supervision:

**Direct**-the supervising physician is physically present with the resident and patient.

\*A faculty physician, other than another resident, is physically present during the key portions of the procedure or is immediately available.

**Indirec**t-the supervising physician is physically within the hospital or other site of patient care and is immediately available to provide direct supervision.

**Oversight**- the supervising physician is available to provide review of procedures/encounters with feedback after care is provided.
