OPW	Sim Lab	Simulation and Skills Lab (5 days) - 25% of block
	Psych/Add	Psych/Addiction Medicine (5 days) - 25% of block
	Pain Mgmt	Pain Management (5 days) - 25% of block
	CC /Admin	Flexible time for well-being, administrative tools, and scholarly pursuits - 5 days

Continuity Clinic	Continuity ambulatory outpatient medicine clinic, 2 half days a week for adult AIM block , 1/2 day a week for other blocks
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IEE	Individualized Educational Experience: Educational Experience will take into account residents' future plans. Determined by program director. May include more ambulatory/outpatient experiences for residents who are interested in practicing in an outpatient setting after residency, more inpatient experiences for those interested in hospitalist medicine carriers, or more experiences in a subspecialty for those interested in subspecializing
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FLEX	Rotation assigned at discretion of the program based upon perceived resident training needs, coverage gaps (i.e. backup), and resident preference. Generally rotations assigned are from the same group as IEE barring need for emergency coverage of a core service
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VACATION	PGY1: 15 days or 3 weeks PGY2: 15 days or 3 weeks PGY3: 20 days or 4 weeks (one week reserved for last block of AY as a transitional period)
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RESEARCH	Research is conducted throughout the academic year.
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
