The GCNMS is a multinational research consortium, with 82 country members, that she founded to develop research capacity amongst nurses and midwives globally. She was the 2019–2020 Distinguished Nurse Scholar in Residence for the National Academy of Medicine, where she worked on the consensus study "Future of Nursing 2020–2030."
