According to the World Health Organization, about 170 million people are chronically infected with the Hepatitis C virus.

The Centers for Disease Control estimates that 3.9 million Americans have been infected with Hepatitis C. If this disease is not treated, Hepatitis C can lead to liver cancer, liver damage and or liver failure.
