What is Rheumatoid Arthritis?

Rheumatoid arthritis (RA) is an autoimmune, inflammatory disease that affects the joints. RA happens when the body's immune system fails and attacks the lining of joints. RA triggers inflammation that quickly flares and causes severe pain and swelling in your joints. Joints can break down and become very difficult to bend or use. RA may affect other organs, too, such as the eyes, lungs, heart or skin.
