### Identifying Risk Factors

# Research shows, screening and early detection of breast cancer leads to effective management and increases overall survival.

Breast density is only one of many risk factors. An APP (Advanced Practice Provider) will help you identify individual risk factors and discuss your personal risk scores.

Estimated risk is calculated from information you provide at the time of your mammography visit, such as family history of breast cancer, and the information in your electronic medical record.

#### The Importance of Supplemental Screening

The average lifetime risk of breast cancer is approximately 13%. Patients with a lifetime risk of more than 20% are considered to have an elevated risk of developing breast cancer.



The American Cancer Society recommends that women with a 20% or greater lifetime risk consider supplemental screening exams, such as annual breast MRI.

Our breast care coordinator can provide additional information and assist you with any referrals that are needed. Some common referrals include genetics, nutrition, smoking cessation, and weight management.
