What to Know Before Surgery about **Common Medications and Supplements**

Many common medications and herbal supplements can impact your surgery. They can increase your risk of bleeding, change how you respond to anesthesia or interfere with the healing process. That is why you should stop taking these medications or supplements at least a week before your surgery.

Common Medications	Possible Side Effects	When to stop taking
Aspirin, NSAIDs & Anti-inflammatories Examples: • Meloxicam (Mobic®) • Ibuprofen (Advil®, Motrin®) • Naprosyn (Aleve®, Naproxen®) • Diclofenac (Voltaren®, Arthrotec®) • Celecoxib (Celebrex®) • Ketorolac (Toradol®) • Nabumetone (Relafen®)	Can increase your risk of bleeding during surgery	Stop taking 7 days before surgery
Phentermine (for weight loss) Examples: Adipex® Atti-Plex P® Lomaira® Fastin® Pro-Fast® Phentride®	 Can increase your heart rate or blood pressure Can cause other heart-related problems Can interfere with anesthesia 	Stop taking 7 days before surgery
Other weight loss or diabetes medications Examples: • Dulaglutide (Trulicity®) • Semaglutide (Ozempic®, Weygovy®) • Liraglutide (Victoza®, Saxenda®) • Tirzepatide (Mounjaro®)	Can increase the risk of stomach contents entering the lungs	Stop taking 7 days before surgery

Supplements & Herbal Medications	Possible Side Effects	When to stop taking
Omega 3 – Fish Oil	 Can increase your risk of bleeding during surgery 	Stop taking 7 days before surgery
All Vitamins, CBD supplements, Garlic, Ginger, Turmeric/Tumeric, Gingko Biloba	Can increase your risk of bleeding during surgery	Stop taking 7 days before surgery
Echinacea	 Can interact with drugs that impact the liver and increase their effects 	Stop taking 7 days before surgery

Supplements & Herbal Medications	Possible Side Effects	When to stop taking
Ephedra (Ma Huang)	 Can increase your heart rate or blood pressure during anesthesia Can increase the effects of drugs that affect your nervous system 	Stop taking 7 days before surgery
Ginseng	 Can increase your risk of bleeding Can alter your blood sugar Can interact with drugs that affect your nervous system 	Stop taking 7 days before surgery
St. John's Wort	 Can make anesthesia last longer than normal Can increase the risk of shivering, diarrhea, rigid muscles, fever or seizures with anesthesia 	Stop taking 7 days before surgery
Kava	Can prolong sedation or keep you more deeply asleep than normal	Stop taking 7 days before surgery
Valerian	Can prolong sedation or keep you more deeply asleep than normal	Begin tapering down how much you take 14 days before surgery
