COVID-19 RESEARCH UPDATE



Amy Feehan, PhD

The Pandemic Response Research Fund was used for the Seroprevalence COVID-19 trial in New Orleans conducted by Amy Feehan, PhD. Using a novel recruitment method and paired molecular and antibody testing for severe acute respiratory syndrome Coronavirus 2 infection, Dr. Feehan's study determined seroprevalence in a racially diverse municipality in Louisiana. Infections were highly variable by zip code and differed by race/ethnicity. Overall, census-weighted seroprevalence was 6.9 percent, and the calculated infection fatality ratio was 1.61 percent.




