

Visitation Guidelines

Please help us foster a quiet, caring environment for our patients, visitors, and staff by following the guidelines below.

Labor & Delivery Unit and OB Emergency Department

- **OB Emergency Department:** One (1) support person is allowed. Once evaluation is completed, the patient's visitor may remain at bedside.
- **Recovery Room:** Two (2) support people per patient at any time are allowed in the recovery room.
- **Operating Room:** One (1) support person can enter the operating room once permitted by the healthcare team.
- **During labor (in LDR):** Four (4) visitors per patient at any time.
- **Once the room is set up for delivery (or in the event of an emergency):** Two (2) support people can remain in the room.
- **Children (under 18), including siblings, are not allowed in Labor and Delivery or the Obstetrical Emergency Department at any time.**

Mother-Baby Unit and Antepartum Unit

- Four (4) visitors are allowed per patient at one time.
- Visiting Hours are between 7:00am and 9:00pm.
- We are committed to providing our patients with 2 hours of uninterrupted peace and quiet on the Mother Baby Unit every day from 2:00pm- 4:00pm when visiting hours are closed.
- **Children of the patient may visit and must *always* be accompanied by a responsible adult visitor.**
- Visiting after 9:00pm is limited to one (1) support person over the age of 18 who may spend the night in the patient's room continuously until 7:00am.
- Children may not spend the night (9:00pm-7:00am) under any circumstances.
